Eclipse Rich Ajax Platform Project (RAP)



RAP enables developers to build rich, AJAX-enabled web applications by using the Eclipse development model, plug-ins and a Java-only API

- RCP is a well established application platform
- Growing demand for Ajax-enabled web applications
- RAP allows to develop Ajax web applications using the RCP development model:
 - coding in Java
 - UI development with SWT, JFace, Workbench
 - facilitate multi-user access to the Workbench
- Build on top of Equinox, running in server environments
 - Application runs on the server and can be accessed with a browser
- Provides Eclipse extension point mechanism
- RAP complies with the JEE servlet standards 2.3, 2.4 and 2.5
- RAP applications can be deployed as standard web archives (war)
