- Why Joining Papyrus IC
 - Join a vibrant community composed of end-users, suppliers, researchers and educators focused on the development of an industrial open source MBE solution
 - Be able to get in touch with tool experts (end-users, suppliers, developers)
 - Increase collaborations both with industry (end-user and supplier organizations)
 and other research/academia organizations
 - Work directly with other organizations (end-users, suppliers, and research/academia) to foster innovations and increase tech transfer
 - Increase opportunities to participate in collaborative research projects focused on the development of key MBE technologies with industrial members (end-user and supplier organizations)
 - Contribute to and take advantage of shared teaching material for MBE courses
 - Contribute to the organization of and participate in events (workshops, conferences, round-tables, etc) focused on open source development and industrial usage of MBE
 - Avoid duplication of (efforts)
 - Improve consolidation of efforts
 - Possibility of pooling resources
 - Be able to influence the direction of the Papyrus family
 - Increase visibility to other organizations

the Eclipse Foundation as Associate Member

- Cost
 - Free for non-for-profit organizations, standards bodies, universities, research institutes, media and publishing, government and other organization types as defined by the Eclipse Foundation board of directors.
 - All other organizations, including for-profits, may also become Associate Members with annual dues of \$5,000USD per year
- Signature of Eclipse agreements
